

Netherland Dwarf

The rabbit is a herbivorous animal belonging to the leporidae family of the lagomorpha order. It is said that there are about 50 different breeds of rabbit in the world. They have distinctively long ears, which have evolved that way to help protect them from predators, and long feet, which also keep them safe from enemies by allowing them to hear their movements from far away. This papercraft model is based on the Netherland Dwarf, a breed of rabbit popularly kept as a pet.

★ **Assembly Instructions**

- 1) Carefully cut out the parts.
- 2) Fold along the dotted lines, making mountain or valley folds as indicated.
- 3) Follow the order indicated in the instructional diagrams, and attach the parts to assemble.
(Read the Explanation of Symbols for more information.)
- 4) Your paper craft model is finished!

★ **Tools**

Scissors, glue (We recommend craft glue.)

★ **Caution**

Keep scissors and glue away from small children.
Be careful not to cut your fingers when using scissors.
Fold the folding lines before gluing.

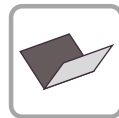
★ **Explanation of Symbols**



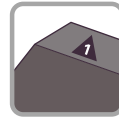
————— **Cut line**

△ **Numbered glue tabs**
Glue the parts together in the order indicated by the numbers.



△ **Glue tabs with symbols and part names**
These tabs are to be glued onto the matching parts, which name is indicated on the tab.

★ Assembling the Netherland Dwarf

1 Assemble the body

Body

2 Assemble the chest

Chest

3 Assemble the head

Head

4 Assemble the ears

Right ear

Fold in half and glue the reverse side together, then cut out.

Assemble the left ear in the same way.

5 Assemble the legs

Right front leg

Assemble the left front leg and the hind legs (right and left) in the same way.

6 Attach the head and ears

7 Attach the body and chest

8 Assemble the whole body
