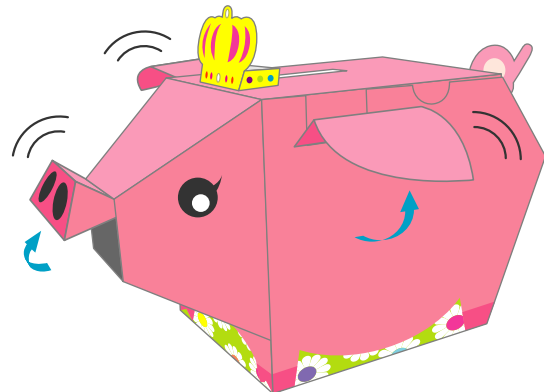
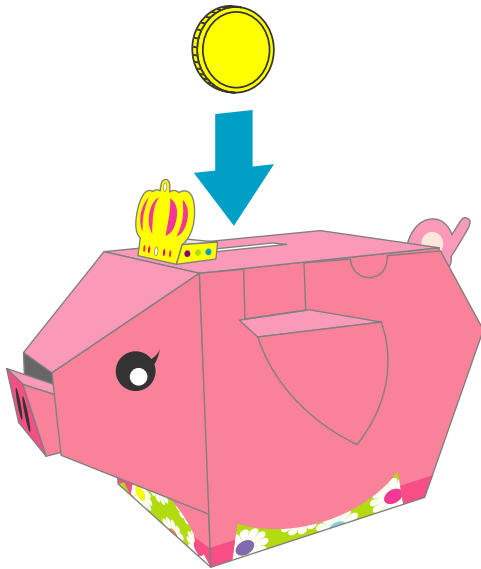


Drop in a coin and watch the money box move!
It's so cute that you won't be able to stop saving!

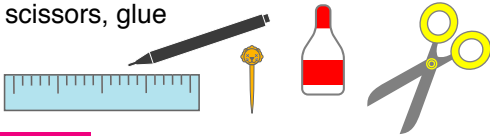
The movements work better with heavier coins.

Tips for a neater finish

☆ Line a ruler up with the dotted lines, and use a sharp, pointed object (eg. a dried-up pen) to score along the fold lines. Carefully make mountain and valley folds to make clean creases on each part.

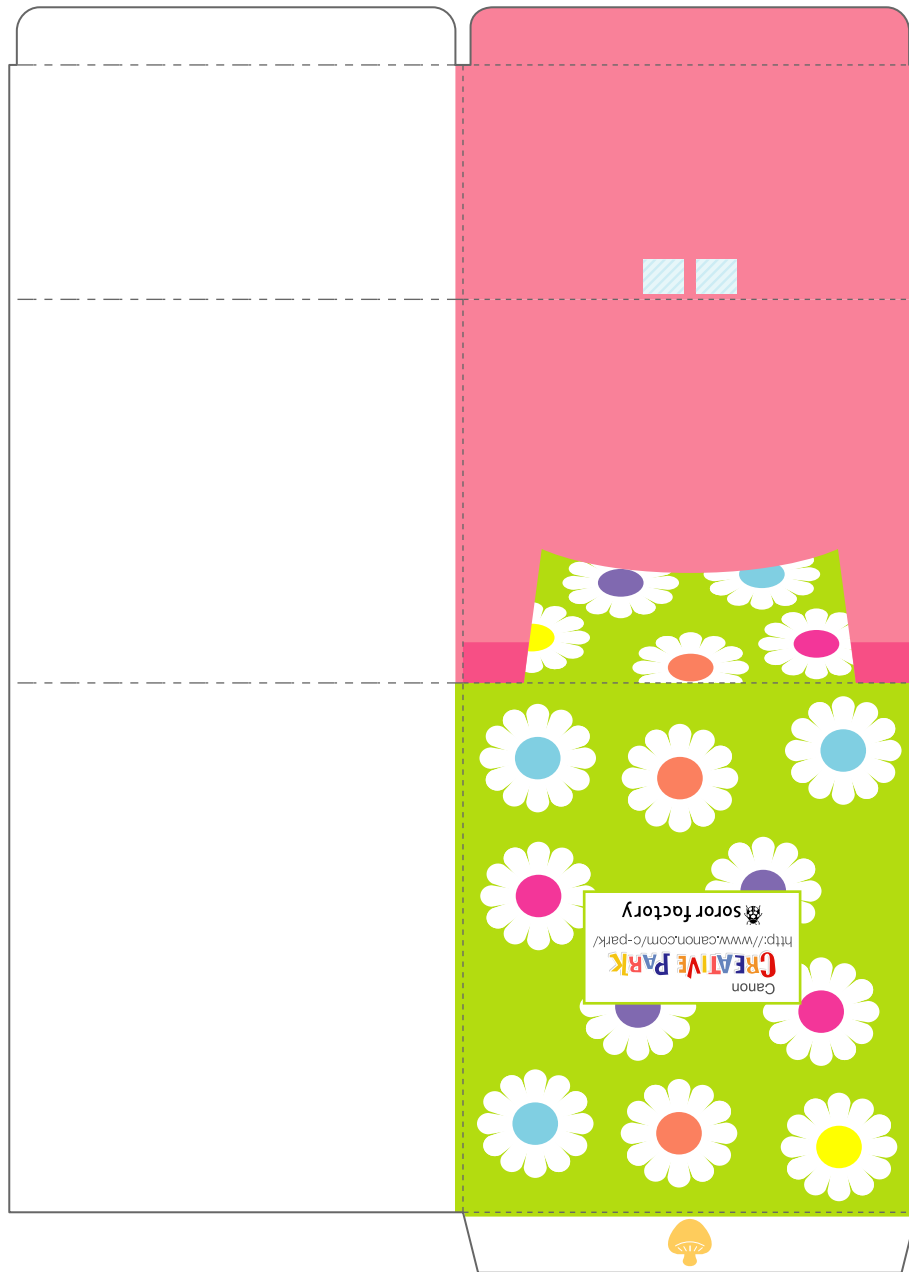
☆ If using craft glue, pour some glue onto scrap paper and use a toothpick to apply it in a thin layer. This will achieve a neater finish.

This paper craft uses glue, scissors, etc, so please be sure to keep them out of reach of children while working.

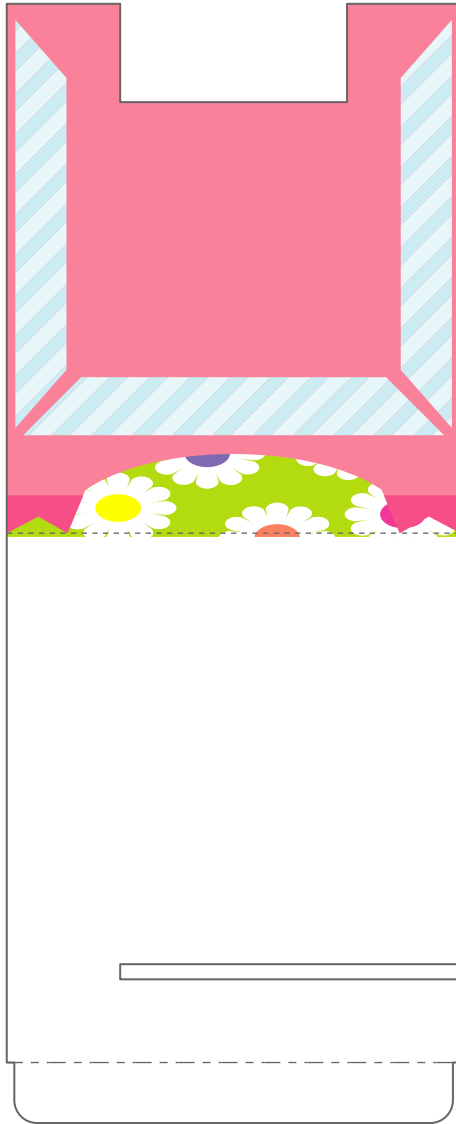
