Explanation of Symbols

- Valley fold
- Cut line
- ◻●◻ Glue spot

Tools and materials

Scissors, glue, ruler, a used ball-point pen, string (white)

Assembly tip

Trace along the folds with a ruler and a used pen (no ink) to get a sharper, easier fold.

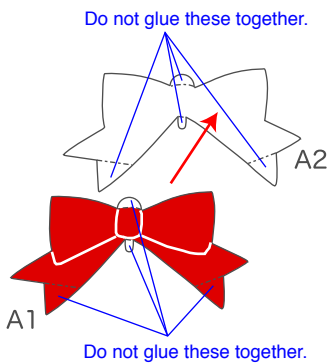
Caution

Glue, scissors and other tools may be dangerous to young children so be sure to keep them out of the reach of young children.

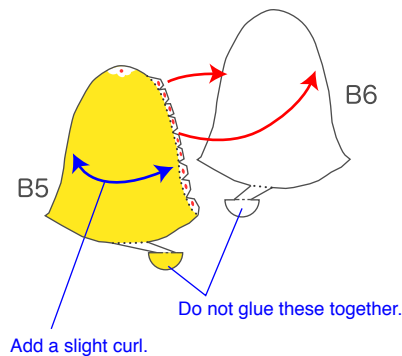
Be careful not to cut your fingers when using scissors.

Instructions

(1) Glue A1 and A2 together.

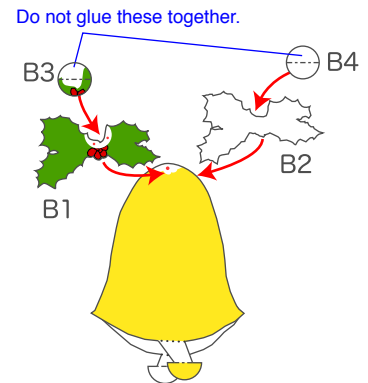


(2) Glue B5 and B6 together.



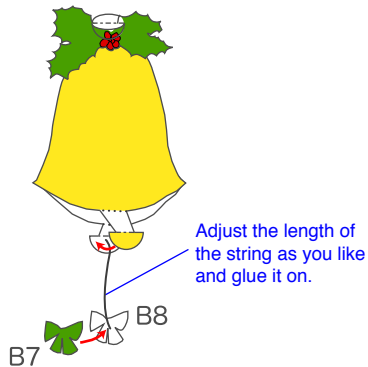
\*Glue C5, C6, and from D5, D6 together in the same way.

(3) Glue B1 and B2 together with the bell in between, and glue B3 and B4 together.



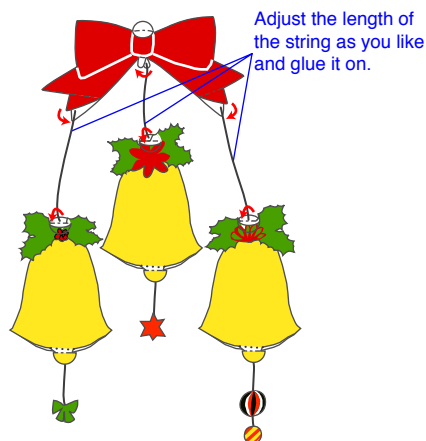
\*Glue C1 to C4, and from D1 to D4 together in the same way.

(4) Fasten the bell, B7, and B8 together with string.

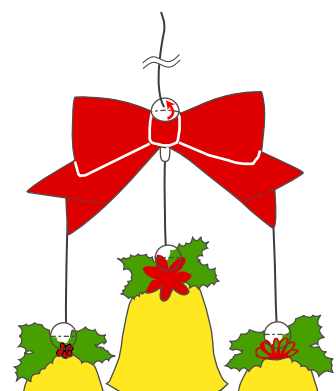


\*Glue C7, C8, and from D7 to D10 together in the same way.

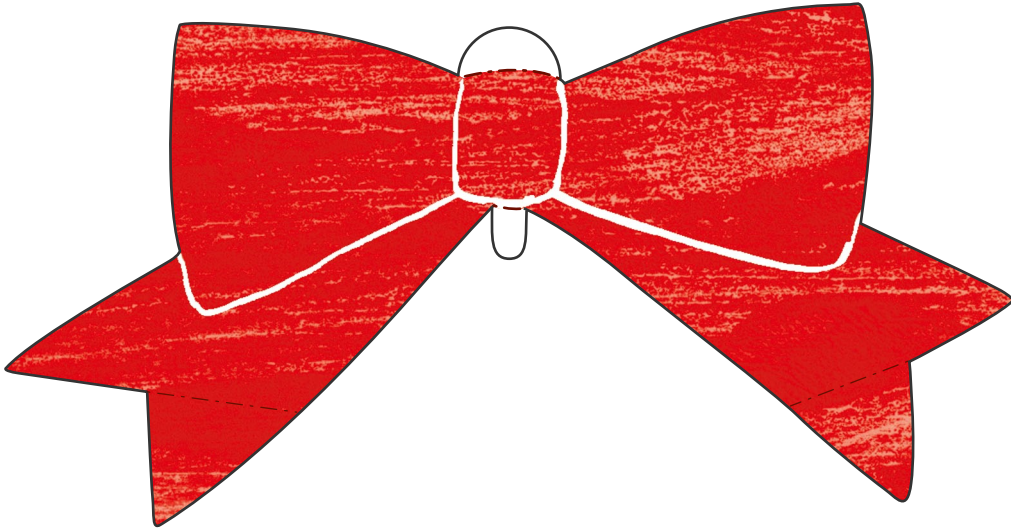
(5) Fasten the bells and the ribbon together with strings.



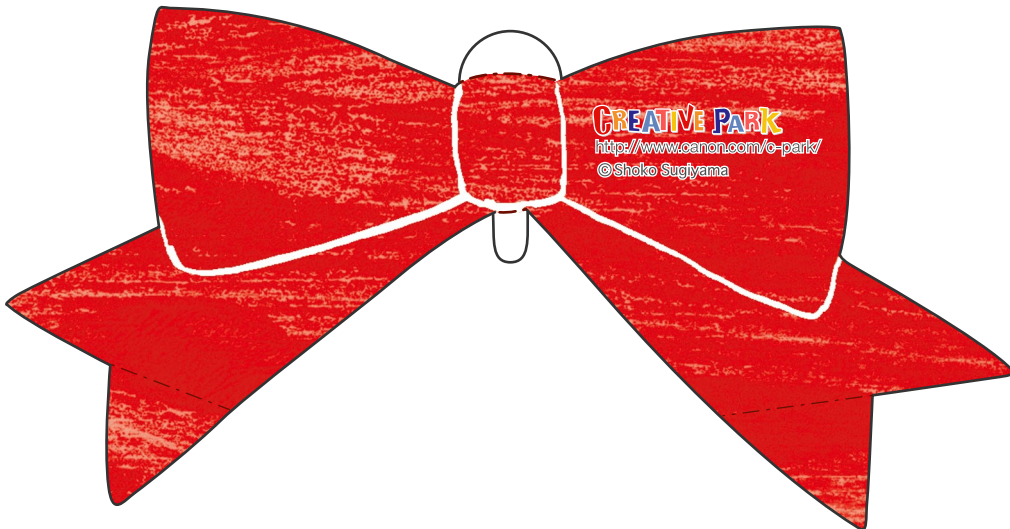
(6) Glue a string to the ribbon, hang it for example from the ceiling, and it's done!
