● You will need

Scissors, glue, ruler, rubber band, rounded pencil (or similar object), dried-up ballpoint pen (Begin by placing the ruler against the fold lines and drawing the empty ballpoint pen over them so that it is easy to make clean folds.)

● Lines and icons

Scissors line ——— Mountain fold - - - - - Valley fold - - - - -

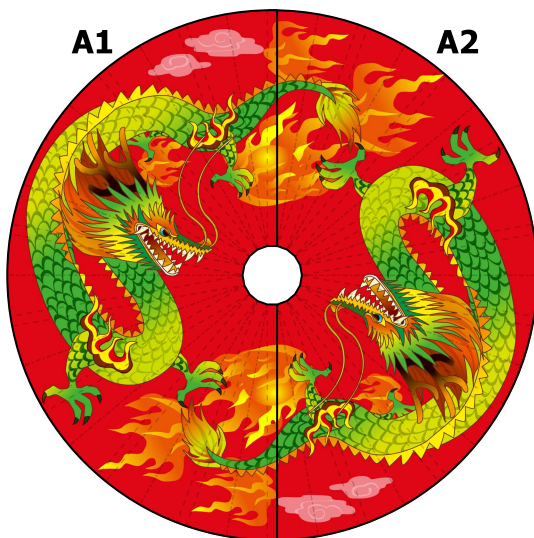
Glue tab ● Cut out ✂

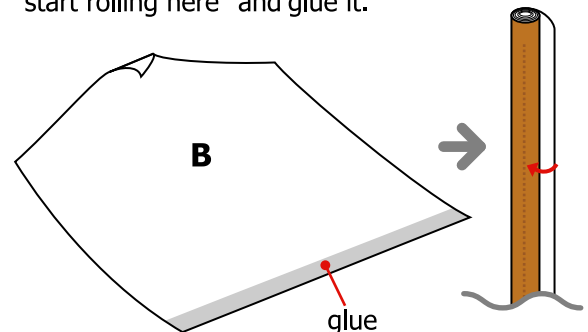
Glue, scissors and other tools and materials may be harmful to children. Please keep your work out of the reach of children.

1 Make the umbrella surface and handle.

Glue A1 and A2 together, and fold to make sharp creases.



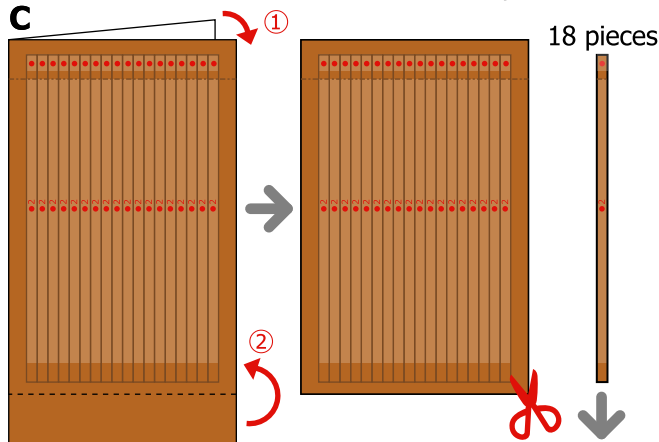
Roll B up tightly beginning from the end marked "start rolling here" and glue it.



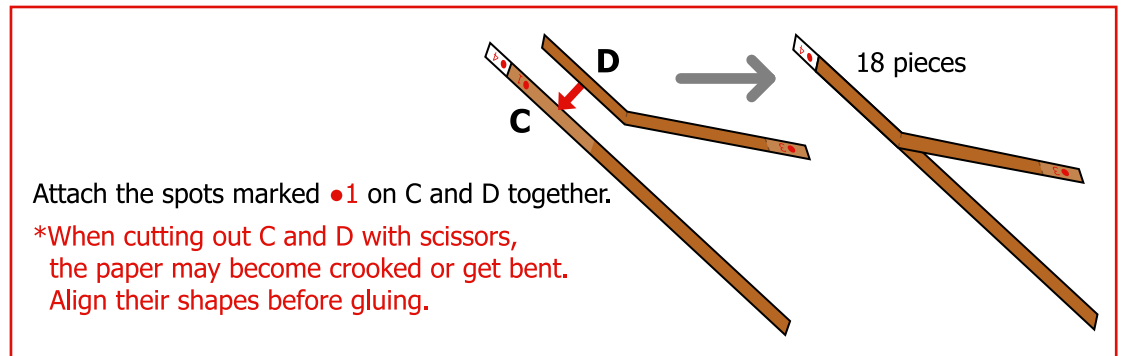
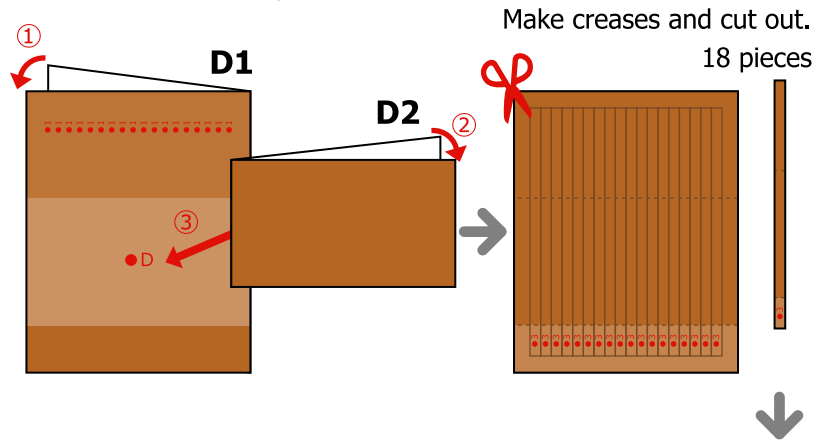
Rolling will be easier if you curl the paper around a rounded pencil or other object first to curve it into shape.

2 Make the spokes

Fold and glue C in half and in half again (in order), fold to make creases and cut out the parts.

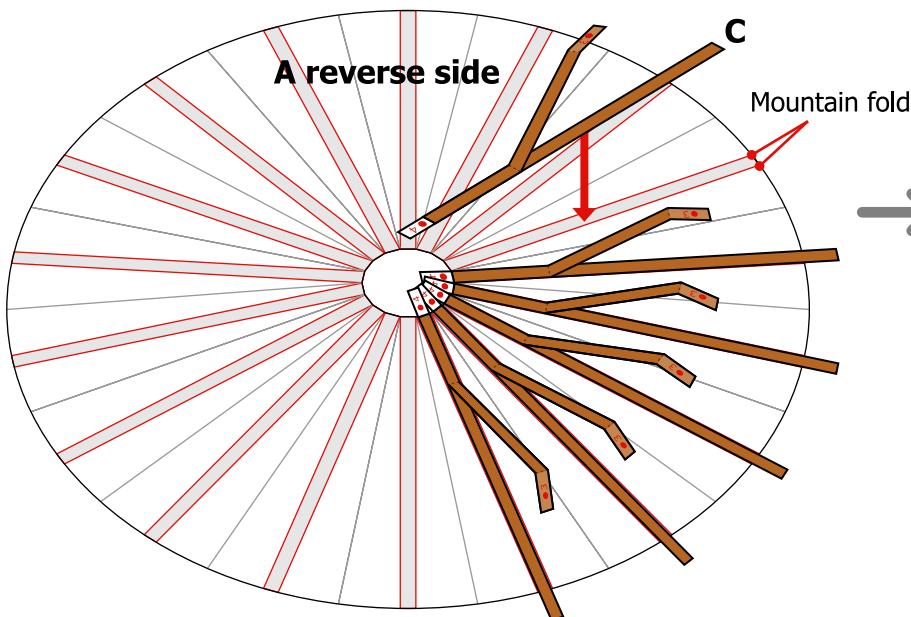


Fold and glue D1 and D2 in half, and attach the two spots marked ●D.

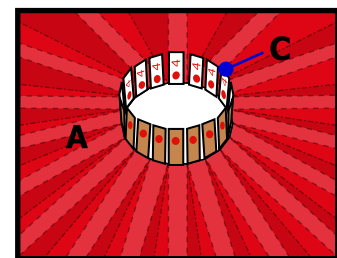


3 Attach the parasol surface and the spokes

Attach the spot marked ●2 on C between the mountain fold lines on the reverse side of A.

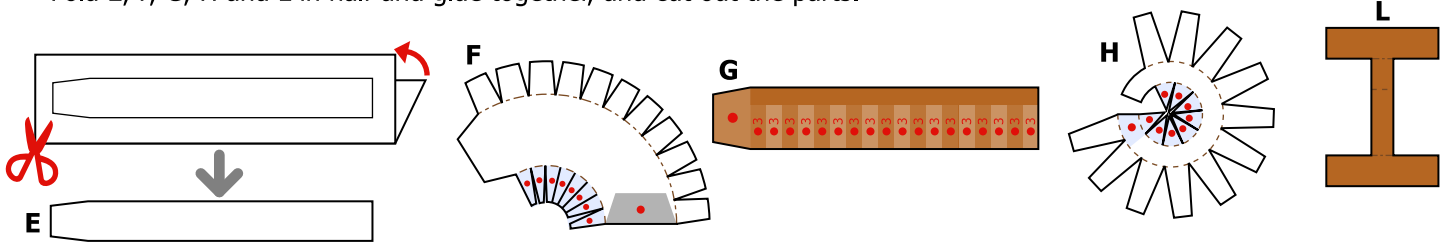


Make valley folds on the spot marked ●4 on C to fold the piece back.

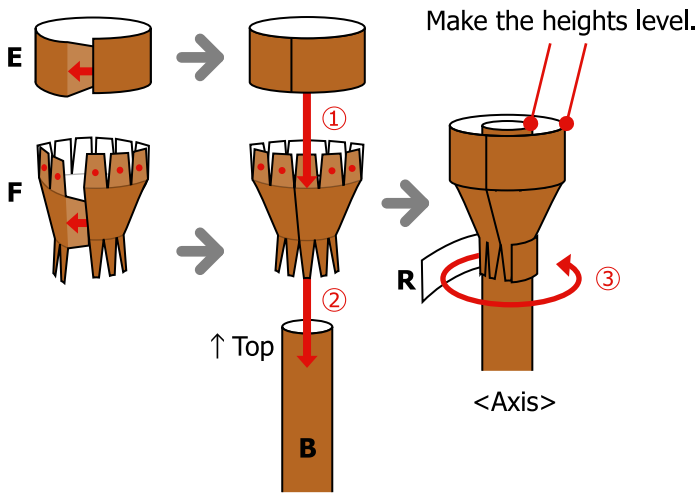


4 Assemble the axis parts

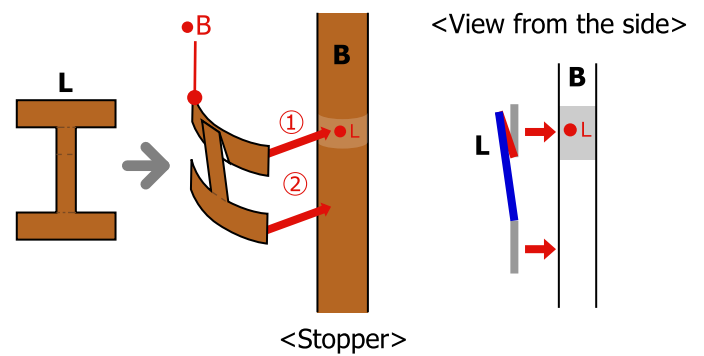
Fold E, F, G, H and L in half and glue together, and cut out the parts.



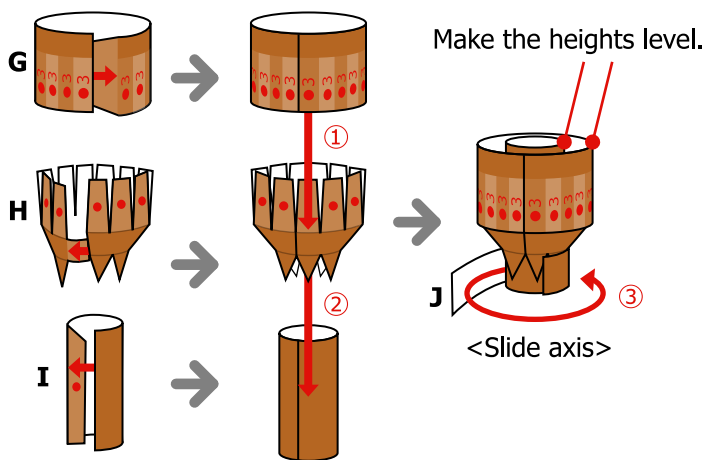
Attach the assembled E, F and B, wrap R around them, and make the "axis."



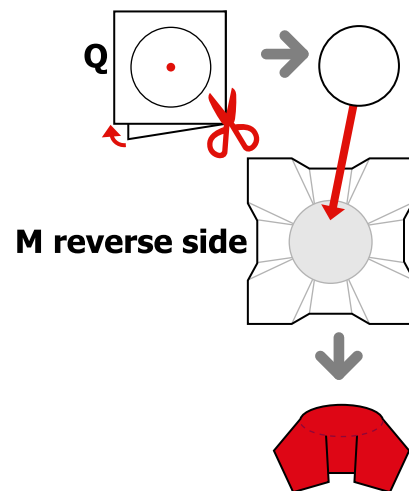
Curve the glue tabs on L, and wrap the part marked ●B around the part on B marked ●L. Keeping L folded up, wrap the bottom glue tab around B.



Attach the assembled G, H and I, wrap J around them and make the "slide axis."



Fold Q in half and glue it together, and cut it out.

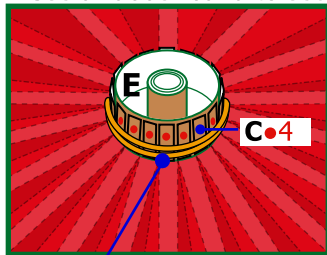


Glue to the center of the reverse side of the creased M.

5 Attach the parts together to complete your umbrella

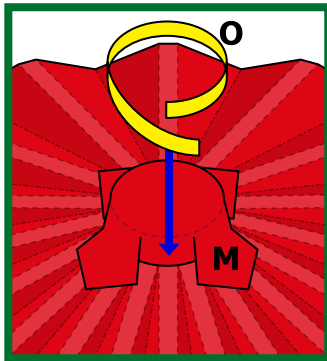
Insert E into the center of A, and glue the glue tabs marked ●4 on C to E.
Use a rubber band to secure them until the glue dries.

Slip the "side axis" (G+H+J) onto B, align the spots marked ●3 on D and G and glue them together, and wrap K around.

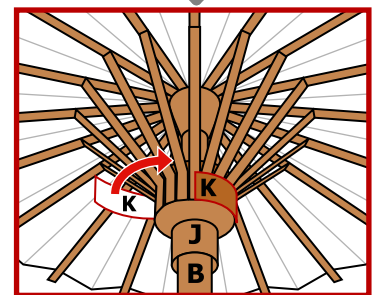
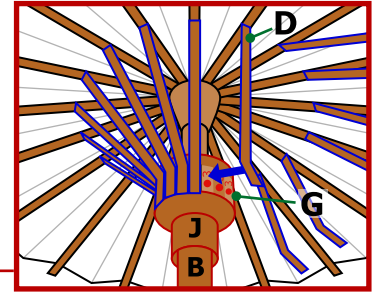


Rubber band

Attach M to the "axis", and wrap the "decorative strip" O around.

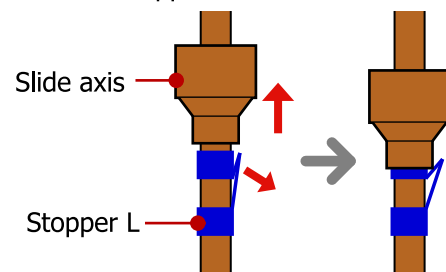


Wrap N around B.

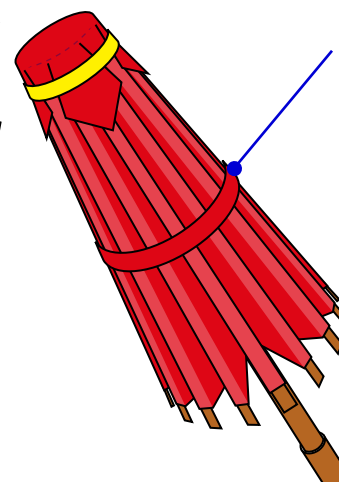
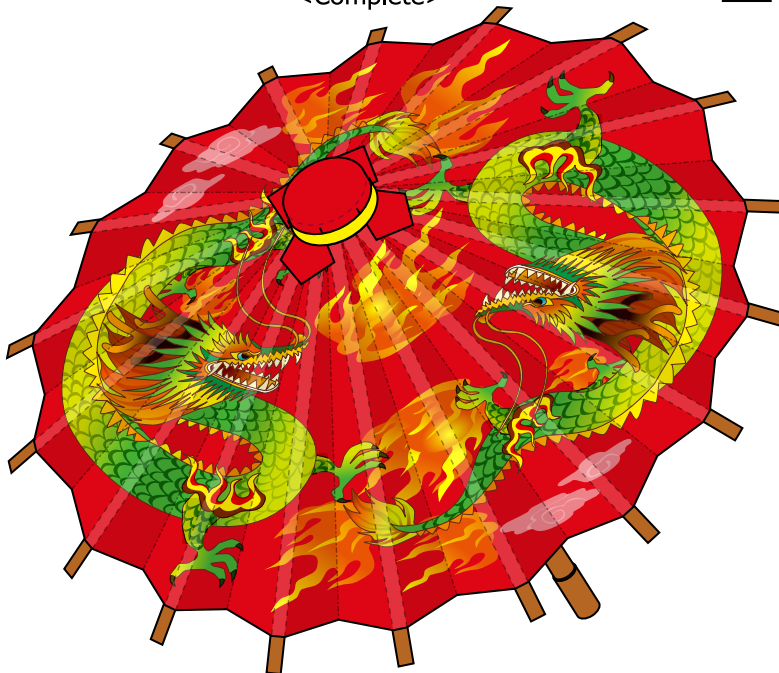


<How to use the stopper>

Use the stopper L to hold the umbrella open.

Glue P into a ring shape.

Slide on from the top to hold the umbrella closed.
