



Roll B up tightly beginning from the end marked "start rolling here" and glue it.




Rolling will be easier If you curl the paper around a rounded pencil or other object first to curve it into shape.




Make the spokes

Attach the spot marked •2 on C between the mountain fold lines on the reverse side of A.








Assemble the axis parts


Fold E, F, G, H and L in half and glue together, and cut out the parts.




Attach the assembled E, F and B, wrap R around them, and make the "axis."




Curve the glue tabs on L, and wrap the part marked •B around the part on B marked •L. Keeping L folded up, wrap the bottom glue tab around B.



Attach the assembled G, H and I, wrap J around them and make the "slide axis."



Fold Q in half and glue it together, and cut it out.



Glue to the center of the reverse side of the creased M.
