

"MUMMY ATTACK" VIGNETTE INSTRUCTIONS

step 1



You really don't need many different tools to build this papercraft model: just a sharp knife (and a cutting mat ;o) glue, and maybe a toothpick (and any other tool you like to use! ;o)

step 2



Cut out the centers of part 1 and fold over the glueing tabs, and then cut out and assemble part 2 (with the coloured side in!)

step 3



Do the same for part 3 and then glue parts 2 and 3 behind part 1.

step 4



Cut out and assemble parts 4 and 5; not the bigger glueing tab on part 4, which needs to be folded *upwards*! (it will become the hinge of the lid)

step 5



Use the big glueing tab to glue the two halves of the sarcophagus (parts 4 and 5) together.

step 6




Now glue the outside of the sarcophagus (parts 4+5) over the inside (parts 1-3). Take your time to glue all the edges and glueing tabs together properly.

step 7



Cut out the hole on part 6 and glue together the sides, but before closing the bottom, cut out and glue together part 7...

step 8




...and glue part 7 underneath the hole on part 6, so that the tallest side is at the front (so that it slopes down towards the back).

step 9



That way, the sarcophagus will tilt a little bit backwards when you glue it on top of the stand.

step 10



Cut out and assemble part 8 by glueing together the ends marked A and B, and following the arrow guide on the template.

step 11



Assemble part 9...

step 12



...and then glue it to part 8, together with the rest of the right leg (parts 10-13). Do the same for the left leg (parts 14-18).

step 13



Cut out the small, yellow slit on part 19 before glueing it to the rest of the legs.


Then push the two bigger glueing tabs on the bottom of part 20 through the slit and between the backside of part 19 to glue it on top of part 19.

step 14



The result should like like this.

step 15



Cut out and assemble parts 21 and 22...

step 16



...and then glue them together like so.

step 17



Make sure to score and fold all the fold lines on part 23 so you can shape it as shown here...

step 18




...so you can glue it to the shoulder like so.

step 19



Keep assembling and glueing on the rest of the right arm (parts 24-28).

step 20



Now shape and assemble parts 29 and 30...

step 21




...and glue them to the other shoulder like so.

step 22



Keep assembling and glueing on the rest of the left arm (parts 31-34).

step 23



Cut out the small, yellow slit on part 35 before glueing it to the bottom of the mummy's torso (leave the bottom open until last to make it easier). Part 36 can be used to cover up the loose piece of mummy bandage. ;o)

step 24



With the bottom closed, it will look like this. Now cut out and assemble the neck (part 37)...

step 25



...and then glue part 37 on top of the torso, and push the two bigger glueing tabs on top of part 20 through the slit and between the back-side of part 35 to glue the mummy's torso to the legs.

step 26



Take your time scoring and folding all the fold lines on part 38 to make it easier to glue together like so.

step 27



Glue on part 39, and cut out and assemble part 40...

step 28



...so that you can glue it on too.

step 29



step 30



The mummy won't be able to stand on its own, so use some glue or some doublesided tape underneath its feet.
